Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.72 dated 18.04.2018 under Section 22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station City Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, the police party apprehended the petitioner on suspicion and recovered 804 tablets of Tramadol Hydrochloride. It is further submitted that the petitioner is in custody for the last about 01 year and 21 days and it will take some time in conclusion of the trial.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate and as per the custody certificate, apart from this case, the petitioner is involved in two more FIRs under NDPS Act and two FIRs under IPC.

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After hearing learned counsel for the parties and considering the allegations that recovery is of commercial quantity, I find no ground to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

The mere fact that the petitioner is in custody for the last 01 year and 21 days, is no ground to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
