Disposed of.

Main Case

After arguing for sometime, when the Bench was not agreeable to contentions of the petitioner on the basis whereof he has challenged the order dated 02.12.2019 (Annexure P1) whereby he was declared as a proclaimed person, counsel for the petitioner would pray that the present petition may be disposed of but without prejudice to right of the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court/Duty Magistrate but some time bound directions may be issued to the Court below for deciding his application for grant of regular bail.

In view of the above, without examining merits of the case, the petition stands disposed of. In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial

Court/Duty Magistrate within a period of seven days and files an application

for grant of regular bail, the same shall be decided by the Court concerned within a period of 10 days from the date of its filing.

However, nothing stated in this order shall be construed as an expression of opinion against plea of the petitioner with regard to his medical condition at the relevant time.
