The petitioner is the accused in FIR No. 247 dated 12.12.2019 on the file of P.S. Dhanaula, District Barnala, registered under Sections 326-A, 326-B and 506 IPC. By way of this petition, he seeks grant of regular bail.

This Court was informed on the last occasion that a compromise was effected by and between the parties. Mr. Mehardeep Singh Dullat, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, was accordingly requested to verify and confirm the factum of such compromise.

Today, Mr. Mehardeep Singh Dullat, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, would inform this Court that the parties settled

the matter amicably.

Mr. Sandeep Siwatch, learned counsel, appearing for the complainant, states that he was unable to file his vakalat but reports that his client has no objection to this petition being allowed.

Given the aforestated developments, this Court is of the opinion that the petitioner would be entitled to relief, subject to conditions.

The petition is accordingly allowed directing the release of the petitioner on regular bail in FIR No. 247 dated 12.12.2019 on the file of P.S. Dhanaula, District Barnala, upon the petitioner furnishing a personal bond for a sum of Rs. 10,000/- along with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Illaqa/Duty Magistrate concerned. Further, the petitioner shall not offer any inducement, threat or promise to any person involved with the case.
