Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.52 dated 27.05.2020, registered at Police Station Kahnuwan, District Gurdaspur, under Sections 323, 324, 379, 447, 511, 506, 148, 149 and 326 (added later on) of the Indian Penal Code.

A Coordinate Bench, on 12.06.2020, passed the following order:

“This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.52 dated 27.05.2020 under Sections 323/324/379/447/511/506/148/149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Kahnuwan, District Gurdaspur.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Luvinder Sofat, AAG Punjab, who has joined proceedings, on service of advance copy of petition, accepts

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notice on behalf of State of Punjab.

Adjourned to 20.08.2020.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join the investigation and make himself available as and when called for. In the event of arrest, he shall be released on interim bail till further orders by this court, on furnishing personal bail bond to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 12.06.2020 passed by the Coordinate Bench, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Prabh Dayal, submits that the petitioner joined the investigation on 20.06.2020 and is now not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 12.06.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
