The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 86 dated 09.11.2019, registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Behram, District SBS Nagar has been registered against the petitioner and co-accused namely, Major Singh in pursuance of recovery of 75 injections of Buprenorphine and 75 injections of Avil which were being carried by them on a motorcycle.

It has been pointed out by the learned counsel for the petitioner that similarly placed co-accused namely, Major Singh has already been granted concession of bail by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in terms of order dated 22.05.2020 passed in CRM-M-12415-2020.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the fact of grant of bail to the co-accused.

As such, without any expression on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing heavy bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
