The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.85 dated 27.04.2020, under Sections 120-B, 188, 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Jhojhu Kalan, District Charkhi Dadri.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation. It is also submitted that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and he has been found innocent.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 12.06.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
