Learned State counsel has placed on record the report of the Tehsildar, Ludhiana Central which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

As per the report, statement of the petitioner was recorded wherein she categorically stated that infact she had returned to her native village of her own accord during the lockdown. It has been further stated that there was no outstanding amount due against the brick kiln owner and further the entire family of the petitioner has since returned to their native village in Uttar Pradesh. Therefore, learned counsel for the State submits that there has been compliance of the order dated 24.5.2020 in CRWP No.3194 of 2020.

In the circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the report of the Tehsildar, Ludhiana Central, nothing survives in the present petition.
