Prayer in the present petition is to issuance of directions
to the respondents as under:-

i) To implement the provisions of the Punjab Regulation
of fee of un-aided Educational Institutions Act, 2016.

ii) Not to increase the monthly fees this year and not to
recover any annual funds.

iii) To implement the provisions of Section 29 of the
Right to Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009
and prescribe the syllabus, curriculum and books prescribed by
the Academic Authority established under Section 29 of the
RTE Act, 2009.

iv) To publish the details and qualifications of its
Principal and Teacher of its official web site and with a further

direction to prescribe the books published by National Council for Education Research and Technology i.e. NCERT.

v) To conduct a detailed inquiry against the financial and other irregularities being committed by respondents No.6 and 7 and to take action on the written representations submitted by the petitioner.

This Court has already decided a bunch of writ petitions vide order dated 30.6.2020 passed in CWP-7409-2020 titled as Independent Schools' Association Chandigarh (Regd.) & others vs. State of Punjab and others.

The present writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of in the same terms as stated above passed in CWP-7409-2020.

The only issue in this writ petition seems to be with respect to the complaint (Annexure P-10) filed by the petitioner before the Regulatory Body i.e. the Punjab Regulation of Fee of Unaided Institutions Act, 2016. It has also been said in order dated 30.6.2020 that the Act in itself is in place for deciding any such complaint filed before it. However, since the said complaint is stated to be pending and the same has not been decided till date. The same be decided expeditiously in accordance with law.
