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LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

The petitioners seek protection of their life and liberty as they apprehend danger at the hands of respondents No.4 to 11. This is so for the reason that they have solemnized marriage out of their own free will and volition, against the wishes of the said respondents.

It is submitted that petitioner No.1 is 19 years old, her date of birth being 21.05.2001. Both the petitioners, it is submitted, are competent to solemnize marriage. It is their first marriage and there is no impediment to the same.

Notice of motion was issued in this matter.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the matter was inquired into by the official respondents and statement of both the petitioners has been recorded to the effect that they do not face threat to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 11 as the matter has been resolved.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the matter has, in fact, been resolved and she has instructions to withdraw this petition.

Petition is accordingly dismissed is withdrawn.
