The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of habeas corpus for release of detainee-Neha from illegal detention of respondents No.3 to 7 alleging receipt of telephonic call from her regarding illegal detention, beating and maltreatment by her parents, husband and in-laws.

Vide order dated 11.06.2020, respondent No.2-the Commissioner of Police, Gurugram was directed to look into the matter personally, take appropriate action in accordance with law for release of the detainee in case of her illegal detention by respondents No.3 to 7 or any other person and to submit a report to this Court on the next date of hearing.

In compliance with the above said order, status report by

way of affidavit of Ashok Kumar, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Old Gurugram on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 has been sent through e-mail print out of which is taken on record. Copy of the statement of detainee-Neha recorded by the Duty Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurugram under Section 164 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 has also been enclosed therewith.

In her statement, detainee-Neha had submitted that she is living with her husband at her matrimonial house happily. She wants to live with her husband and no action may be taken on the petition filed by her friend Surabhi (the present petitioner).

Copy of the status report along with copy of the statement of detainee-Neha has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner does not want to continue with the present petition and the same may be dismissed as withdrawn.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with no order as to costs.
