The petitioner is one of the accused in FIR No.83 dated 04.08.2019 on the file of Police Station Bhargo Camp, Jalandhar, registered under Sections 420, 482 and 34 IPC (Sections 379-B and 411 IPC were added later on). By way of this petition, he seeks grant of regular bail.

The petitioner is in custody since 05.08.2020. The offence alleged is in relation to a motorcycle which admittedly belongs to the brother of the co-accused of the petitioner. There is no indication of any complaint having been lodged by him with regard to the theft of his motorcycle. Given these facts, this Court is of the opinion that the petitioner would be entitled to relief, subject to conditions.

The petition is according allowed directing the release of the

Police Station Bhargo Camp, Jalandhar, upon his furnishing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.20,000/- along with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Duty/Illaqa Magistrate concerned. Further, the petitioner shall not cause any threat, inducement or promise to any person involved with the case.
