Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.168 dated 20.08.2017, under Sections 323/325/506/148/149 IPC, registered at Police Station Hathur, District Ludhiana on the basis of compromise dated 19.01.2018 (Anneuxre P-2) and consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

On 13.07.2018, notice of motion was issued and the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court, however, the needful was not done. Thereafter, on 26.09.2018 again a direction was issued to the parties to appear before the trial Court on 15.10.2018 for recording their statements. However, none of the parties appeared and again third opportunity was granted on 06.12.2018, directing the parties to appear on 08.01.2019 before the trial Court for recording their statements regarding compromise.

As per the reports dated 09.08.2018, 16.10.2018 and

20.02.2019, none of the parties appeared before the trial Court. It is evident that the compromise is not supported by the parties, therefore, the petition fails and is dismissed.

The petition stands dismissed.
