The petitioner is one of the accused in FIR No.340 dated 10.06.2018 on the file of Police Station Sampla, Rohtak, registered under Sections 302, read with Section 34, and Section 404 IPC. By way of this petition, he seeks grant of regular bail.

The petitioner has been in custody since 24.12.2018. The challan was filed upon completion of the investigation and this Court is informed that three witnesses have already been examined. Perusal of the challan reflects that no specific overt acts were attributed to the petitioner and he seems to have been implicated only on the strength of the disclosure statement of the co-accused. That being so, the continued incarceration of the petitioner is not required at this stage. He would therefore be entitled to grant of bail, subject to conditions.

The petition is according allowed directing the release of the petitioner on regular bail in FIR No.340 dated 10.06.2018 on the file of Police Station Sampla, Rohtak, upon his furnishing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.20,000/- along with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Duty/Illaqa Magistrate concerned. Further, the petitioner shall not cause any threat, inducement or promise to any person involved with the case.
