Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking benefit of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.109 dated 6.7.2019 registered under Sections 302, 34 I.P.C at Police Station, Boha, District Mansa.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, the present petitioners are the sister and brother-in-law of deceased Gurcharan Singh, who died on 5.7.2019. Allegations are that the petitioners herein inflicted fatal injuries upon the deceased on account of a property dispute.

Petitioners were arrested on 6.7.2019.

Motive attributed is a property dispute.

During the course of hearing it has gone uncontroverted that material witnesses i.e. mother, father and wife of the deceased have not supported the prosecution version and have been declared hostile.

It is a case of circumstantial evidence there being no eye witness.

In view of the above as also keeping in mind the length of incarceration already suffered, petitioners are held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petitioners be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Mansa.
