Amit Kumar, accused in FIR No.4 dated 14.01.2020 for offence punishable under Section 379-A of Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') registered at Police Station GRP Panipat, District GRP Ambala Cantt., prays for grant of regular bail, pending trial.

Counsel for the State would inform, on instructions from SI Ishwar Singh, that there is no other criminal case registered against the petitioner.

The petitioner is in custody since January 2020. Challan has been presented in the Court and conclusion of trial is likely to take its own time. There is no allegation that petitioner is likely to flee from process of justice, in case enlarged on bail.

In view of the above, without meaning to express any opinion

on merits of the controversy, the petitioner shall be released on bail subject to satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Panipat. However, he shall abide by the following conditions:-

- (i) He shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court;
- (ii) He shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court.

Disposed of accordingly.
