The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of the restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Amit Kumar, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.115 dated 01.05.2020, under Sections 324, 506, 34 IPC, (Section 307 IPC was added lateron) Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Kosli, District Rewari.

Vide order dated 15.06.2020, the petitioner was granted interim bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Narinder, states that the petitioner had joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required. He, however, submits that on 20.07.2020, petitioner-Amit Kumar, himself has unfortunately died.

In view of the above, no further orders are called for.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.
