The prayer in the present petition is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.107 dated 12.03.2020, registered under Sections 148/149/332/353/186/188/120-B/307/427/379 of IPC, Police Station Ferozepur Jhirka, District Nuh.

Issue notice of motion.

Mr. Ramesh Kumar Ambavta, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent/State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners while praying for anticipatory bail submitted that infact on 12.03.2020, son of petitioner No.1 namely Nafish was stopped by the police while he was going on his motorcycle to purchase the medicines. The inflicted injuries on his head with angle rod. Many passers gathered there and it was only then the police personnels themselves took Nafish for medical treatment in the police vehicle because of the condition of Nafish was serious. In order to cover up this injury and their action, the present false FIR has been registered against the petitioner. It is on this account that the FIR itself makes mention of the son of petitioner No.1 having received the injuries.

Where question of the allegations in the present FIR concerned, the injuries are simple in nature.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to join the investigation within a period of two weeks and on their doing so, the petitioners be released on interim bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

In case, the petitioners do not join the investigation or do not cooperate in the investigation, the respondent/State shall be at liberty to file an application for cancellation of their anticipatory bail.
