RAJAN GUPTA, J. (Oral)

Case has been heard through video conferencing in view of
COVID-19 Pandemic.

Petitioner has prayed for parole on the ground that he has to
attend the marriage of his sister.

Learned State counsel at the outset points out that in fact the
girl who is to get married is actually the step sister of the petitioner. He has
not entitled to parole in view of Rule 5-A of Haryana Good Conduct
Prisoners (Temporary Release) Amendment Act.

It has been brought to the notice of the Court that the petitioner
moved Commissioner, Hisar Division for grant of similar relief but the same
has been rejected. Said order is not on record. Under the circumstances, we
remit the matter to the Commissioner, Hisar Division who will have a fresh

look into the matter and pass a speaking order before 26.6.2020. Petitioner shall be at liberty to place reliance on the judgments, if any in his favour which shall be taken into consideration while disposing of the parole petition.
