On 15.6.2020, the following order was passed by this
Court:-

“This matter is being taken up for hearing
through video conference/WhatsApp due to the
pandemic COVID-19.

Mr. Munish Puri contends that the
petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He
submits that the petitioner has not abducted the niece
of the complainant. The petitioner and the niece of the
complainant are major and have solemnized their
marriage. The petitioner and his wife (niece of the
complainant) also got protection of life and liberty
vide order dated 02.06.2020 passed in Criminal Writ
Petition No.3344 of 2020.

Issue: Notice of motion.

Since advance copy of the petition stands already served, Mr. Sandeep Vermani, Addl. AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State, while Mr. Gaurav Partap Singh Pathania, Advocate, puts appearance on behalf of the complainant. Mr. Pathania may file reply if he wishes.

Mr. Vermani on instructions from ASI Niranjn Singh states that the Investigating Agency has verified the factum of marriage.

List on 06.08.2020.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer. Petitioner shall comply with the conditions as stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Niranjn Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the order dated 15.6.2020 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
