The present petition is filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.92 dated 2.6.2020 under Section 22-C/61 of NDPS Act, 1985 & 188 IPC, Police Station Odhan, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner while praying for anticipatory bail submitted that the petitioner has been involved on the basis of disclosure statement and that no other case is pending against him and that it is not commercial quantity.

No doubt, the petitioner is involved on the statement of the co-accused but in such like case, custodial interrogation is necessary to investigate about the origin from where the drugs have been obtained as well as the other persons involved in the racket. This is not fit case for anticipatory bail.

Dismissed accordingly.
