This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a criminal case arising from FIR No.87 dated 11.7.2019, registered under Section 302 IPC and Section 25/27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Nehianwala, District Bathinda.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner has murdered his own mother with his own licensed revolver. Report of the ballistic expert has already been produced.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that 15 prosecution witnesses have already been examined and they have not supported the case of the prosecution.

In the present case, trial has already made substantial progress. Hence, this Court does not find it appropriate to consider the

prayer for bail at this stage. However, the present petition is disposed of with a request to the learned Trial Court to make a sincere endeavour to expeditiously conclude the trial.
