1. This petition has been filed against the order of the respondent No.2 whereby it has directed the petitioner to deposit 20% of the disputed amount during the pendency of appeal against the assessment.
2. The only prayer made is that this amount should be reduced in view of the pandemic situation.
3. In our opinion, by limiting the demand to 20%, as of now substantial relief has been granted to the petitioner. Consequently, no further action is required by this Court.

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4. Petition is dismissed.
5. Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.M. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
