On account of outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic, the matter is taken up through video conferencing.

Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents.

In compliance of order dated 16.06.2020, status report by way of affidavit of Superintendent of Police, Sirsa on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 as well as reply filed on behalf of respondents No.4 to 6 have been placed on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is yet to receive the copy of replies so far.

Learned counsel for the State undertakes to supply the copy of status report to the counsel opposite during the course of the day. He further submits that the petitioner has made statement before Women Mediation

Cell/Authorities that she does not apprehend any danger to her life and liberty from anyone.

A perusal of reply filed by respondents No.4 to 6 reveals that the allegations levelled against the said respondents were found to be baseless and not supported by any iota of any evidence. Learned counsel for the respondents have drawn the attention of this Court to Annexure R-4/2, which is the statement of father of the petitioner, to the effect that no such harassment much less any demand of dowry, physical torture etc. was ever made to their daughter or to them.

In view of the statements made by the petitioner and the affidavits filed by respondents No.4 to 6, no ground for interference is made out. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
