1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.267 dated 09.12.2019 registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.
2. By an order dated 16.06.2020, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner and directed him to join investigation.
