GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner-Geetu, who is stated to be aged 44 years, has filed the present writ petition *inter alia* with a prayer to quash the transfer order dated 28.05.2020 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.2. Learned counsel submits that vide impugned order, the petitioner has been transferred from Shree Jainender Gurukul Sector-1, Panchkula to Sh. Mahavir Jain Public School, Kurukshetra.

On a question put by this Court that as to why the petitioner did not approach the Educational Tribunal, learned counsel submits that an effort was made by the petitioner to list the matter before the Educational Tribunal, but, when it was not entertained, they had no other option but to file the present writ petition.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajneesh Chadwal, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondent.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner makes an oral request to implead Educational Tribunal, Panchkula-cum-

District Judge, Panchkula, as party-respondent No.3 to the petition.

An oral request made by the counsel, is accepted.

Educational Tribunal, Panchkula-cum-District Judge, Panchkula, is impleaded as respondent No.3.

Registry is directed to make the necessary addition/correction in the memo of parties and add the above Tribunal as respondent No.3.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the Educational Tribunal, to entertain the petition submitted by the petitioner and considering the request made by counsel for the petitioner for interim stay, decide the application for interim stay within a period of one week, from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

In view of the present COVID-19 situation, learned State counsel and Registry is directed to convey this order to the Competent Authority through e-mail.
