Case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.265 dated 17.10.2017, registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar Rural.

Earlier also, the petitioner had misused the concession of bail. However, ignoring his said lapse, he was ordered to be admitted to bail. This is for the second time, petitioner absented during trial. The medical certificates (Annexure P-5), relied upon by the petitioner, are of not much help to him, inasmuch as, when he could visit Harshil Hospital, Mahilpur (Hoshiarpur), for his physiotherapy, in that eventuality, he could also attend the court on

11.10.2019.

Considering the overall facts and circumstances of the case, petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial court within a week and move application for bail which shall be decided on merit.

The instant petition stands disposed of accordingly.
