GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

Petitioner-Paramveer Singh, stated to be aged 32 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.88 dated 07.04.2020 under Section 61 of Excise Act and Sections 201, 436, 188 & 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar, Sirsa.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Sukhdeep Parmar, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, based on the pleadings in the petition, submits that in the FIR, the main allegations are *inter alia* that ASI along with his companions went towards Dhani of Sandeep and then found that Sandeep s/o Dharampal, Rajesh s/o Jeeta and Paramveer s/o Indraj, in collusion with each other, were preparing illegal liquor in the room of

fodder.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it is evident from the allegations that it was allegedly Dhani of Sandeep. He submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated. He further submits that vide order dated 19.05.2020, passed in CRM-M-12529-2020, co-accused/Sandeep has been granted regular bail by this Court.

Keeping in view the peculiar facts as mentioned above and considering the present COVID situation, this Court deems it appropriate to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In view of the above, the petitioner shall join investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
