The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.38 dated 01.03.2020, registered under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Special Task Forces (STF) Wingh, Jalandhar.

Reply filed on behalf of the State is taken on record.

It has come on record that the petitioner was granted interim bail by this Court on 02.09.2020. Thereafter, he was to surrender on 08.09.2020. However, the petitioner has not surrendered to the process of the Court. Hence, he is not entitled to any concession of bail pending trial.

Since the petitioner has over-stayed the duration of interim bail and is still absconding, therefore, it shall be incumbent upon the

Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar to ensure the arrest of the petitioner and to produce him before the trial Court within a period of two month from today. If the petitioner has already fled from the country then the report to this effect shall also be filed by the Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar before the trial Court.
