GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

Petitioner-Pawan stated to be aged 40 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* praying for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.230 dated 28.05.2020 (Annexure P-1) under Section 24 of Immigration Act, 1983 and Sections 406/420 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Gharaunda, District Karnal.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Sukhdeep Parmar, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Mr. Parveen Sharma, Advocate, appeared on behalf of the complainant.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegations in the FIR were of alleged cheating. He submits that vide affidavit (Annexure P-2), the parties have compromised.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant also supports the

above submission made by counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the peculiar facts as mentioned above, keeping in view the present COVID situation and the fact that the matter has been compromised, this Court deems it appropriate to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In view of the above, the petitioner shall join investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. In case, the above submissions are found to be incorrect, the prosecution as well as complainant are at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
