Learned counsel for the petitioner based on pleadings in the writ petition, submits that the petitioner in this regard had submitted representation dated 06.11.2017 (Annexure P-9) but till date no decision has been taken. He also relies on orders (Annexures P-5 to P8) passed by this Court.
