This is application No.3 for grant of regular bail filed by the petitioner in a criminal case arising from FIR No.298 dated 17.09.2017 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 506, 307 of the Indian Penal Code and 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act, at Police Station Sector-31, Chandigarh.

The first application was withdrawn by the learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing for sometime. The second application for grant of bail was dismissed on merits on 28.11.2019.

Learned counsel for the Union Territory, Chandigarh, has stated that the petitioner is involved in as many as 7 more criminal cases of similar nature apart from the present case.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
