This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.39 dated 20.01.2020, under Sections 21, 27-A of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station, City, Rewari, District Rewari.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that recovery, in this case, has been effected from co-accused Badar Ram and he is in custody.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Om Parkash, has informed that as per FSL report, samples have failed and an attempt is being made to send fresh samples to the FSL for examination. She further states that challan has already been presented and charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

Petitioner is in custody since 24.01.2020.

Keeping in view that recovery has not been effected from the petitioner; the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that the trial will take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that no purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Rewari
