Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the nephew of the petitioner, namely, Karmbeer @ Gaggi had been picked up by the police and later on, he was allegedly implicated in FIR No.86 dated 03.06.2020, under Sections 78, 61(1)(14) of the Excise Act and Sections 465, 468, 471, 473 IPC registered at Police Station Bahav Wala, district Fazilka. He further contends that the nephew of the petitioner was beaten up in custody and had been brutally tortured and given electric shocks. The petitioner has preferred an application for medical examination of his nephew, which has been dismissed by the trial Court.

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Dhruv Dayal, Senior DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel through e-mail during the course of the day.

Heard through video conferencing.

The nephew of the petitioner, namely, Karmbeer @ Gaggi is alleged to have been tortured. It would be in the interest of justice and to safeguard the human rights that fresh medical board be constituted to ascertain, if, he has sustained injuries or has been subject to torture at the hands of the police.

Consequently, the petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to the Jail Superintendent, Fazilka to get Karmbeer @ Gaggi (nephew of the petitioner) medically examined within a week, by a Board of Doctors to be constituted by the Civil Surgeon, Fazilka and furnish a report to the petitioner.
