The petitioner has filed the present criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent no.1 and 2 for protection of his life and liberty from the hands of respondent no. 5 to 10.

It is not disputed that petitioner has already been acquitted in the criminal cases filed against him. It is also not disputed that a civil suit is pending between the petitioner and the private respondents. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the respondents had forcibly harvested the crop of the petitioner and threatened him.

In the considered view of this Court, remedy for the petitioner is to file a criminal complaint before the concerned Judicial Magistrate.
