Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all the pleas taken in this petition, before the trial court at an appropriate stage. He has further requested that keeping in view the fact that the petitioner-Tejinder Kaur is an aged woman of 70 years, her personal appearance in the trial court be exempted.

This petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
