This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.19 dated 14.02.2020, under Sections 328, 366, 376-D, 506 IPC, 1860 and Section 3 of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Women Police Station, Narnaul, District Mahendergarh. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of police in the above FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the allegations contained in the FIR are highly improbable and not worth believing. He has invited the attention of the Court to the detailed order dated 17.06.2020, whereby while issuing notice of motion to the respondent-State, the interim protection was extended to the petitioner. According to him, as per the said order, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that in deference to the said order, the petitioner submitted himself before the police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioner cooperated with the police authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by DSP A.S.Kadyan, does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned counsel, on instructions from DSP A.S.Kadyan, further states that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 17.06.2020 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed off.
