Hearing of the case was held through video conference on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner prays for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No. 220, dated 21.08.2019, registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Kotwali, District Patiala, Punjab.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner was apprehended with 1000 capsules PARVN-SPAS PLUS containing Tramadol Hydrochloride salt. The average weight of each capsule is 619 mg. The total quantity recovered, falls in the commercial category.

Mr. Sofat, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, on instructions from ASI Jasmel Singh, has informed the court that the trial has already commenced and the prosecution has already got recorded deposition of two prosecution witnesses, whereas examination of 3 witnesses have been given up. He submits that there are only 6 more witnesses to be examined.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to grant the concession of bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.

However, the learned trial court is requested to expedite the trial of the case.
