This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No. 116 dated 27.10.2019 under Sections 307, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 302 of IPC added subsequently) and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Ghuman, Police District Batala, District Gudaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner while referring to the incident which took place on 27.10.2019 contends that both the sides were having fire-arms and the present petitioner namely Tejinderjit Singh @ Bablu son of late Rupinder Singh and Manjinder Singh son of Pargat had suffered fire arm injuries and left the place for treatment. He further contends that Simranjit Singh @ Simmu son of late Jarnail Singh and Harman Singh son of Jagdish Singh ran away from the spot. Initially the FIR was registered under Sections 307, 148 and 149 of IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act and subsequently challan was presented (Annexure P-2). It is further submitted that when Simranjit Singh @ Simmu was going on his motor-cycle; he received fire arm injury on the arm and in this background, he lost his balance and hit against tree and thereafter he

died.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the petitioner had already left place on account of his receiving injuries and he was not involved in firing arms to Simranjit Singh @ Simmu when he was leaving on his motor-cycle.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Darshan Singh is not disputing this fact that the present petitioner had left the spot after receiving fire arm injuries.

This Court had granted regular bail to Harman Singh @ Hramandeep Singh on 06.03.2020 in CRM-M-9224-2020 in FIR No. 116 dated 27.10.2019 under sections 307, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, wherein the present petitioner-Tejinderjit Singh @ Bablu was the complainant and FIR was with respect to injuries suffered by him on 27.10.2019. The present petitioner compromised the matter with Harman Singh @ Harmandeep Singh and bail was granted to him.

Keeping in view above facts and the fact that no fire arm injury is attributed to the present petitioner, he is ordered to be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
