Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn my attention to the order passed by the coordinate Bench of this Court on 11.12.2019 whereby both the parties were directed to remain present in Court. The parties are present in Court.

Learned counsel for the respondents, upon instructions from the respondent Satish Kumar, who is present in Court, states that he is ready to pay a sum of Rs.1,60,000/- to the petitioner in two equal monthly installments.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, upon instructions from the petitioner, states that the petitioner is also willing to settle the matter and the petitioner should be directed to pay the amount within a period of two months in equal installments.

As agreed between the parties, the respondent Satish Kumar shall pay a sum of Rs.80,000/- to the petitioner within one month from now and the outstanding amount of Rs.80,000/- within a month thereafter. The compromise deed, incorporating the aforementioned terms and conditions has been filed by the parties which is taken on record.

Consequently, the petition is disposed of in terms of the compromise.
