The petitioner is allegedly the leader of a Hindu organization. He is running a transport business and he alleges that on account of his political affiliations, he is being threatened by terrorist organizations. Threats to his life and liberty have already been given as is evident from representations annexed as Annexure P-1 (colly.) and false implication in criminal cases also cannot be ruled out by planting drugs and explosives in the transport being commercially operated by him. Thus, there is an urgent requirement for directing the respondents to provide adequate security to the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sahil Sharma, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents and waives service.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to seek a reply.

At this stage, the petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 to decide the pending representations (collectively) annexed as annexure P-1, the last one being dated 14.5.2020, within a period of two

weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order by passing a speaking order. An opportunity of hearing may also be granted to the petitioner before passing the speaking order.
