Case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.212 dated 16.05.2020, registered at Police Station Ambala Cantt. District Ambala, under Sections 188, 269, 270, 323, 325, 326, 427, 452, 506 and 34 IPC and Section 51 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that neither there is any specific allegation against the petitioner nor any injury has been attributed to him. The main injury has been attributed to co-accused, Rishab. The petitioner has been in custody since 16.05.2020.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. B.S.Virk, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and opposes the prayer made in the present petition. He points out that it was an unlawful assembly

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in which the petitioner had actively participated. He also submits that opinion regarding the main injury being dangerous to life has been kept pending subject to the report of neuro-surgeon.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

No injury has been attributed to the petitioner. There is no specific allegation against him. He has been in custody since 16.05.2020. The trial of the case would take time to conclude. Therefore, no useful purpose would be served by keeping him behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
