1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.

2. Learned counsel contends that despite the petitioner having retired from service on 30.06.2019, retiral benefits have not been released despite representations Annexure P-2 dated 16.11.2019 and legal notice Annexure P-3 dated 5.2.2020 and that in the circumstances the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P-2 dated 16.11.2019 and legal notice Annexure P-3 dated 05.02.2020 respectively, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Upasana Dhawan, Asstt. Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that she has no objection to the limited prayer of the petitioner.

5. Without commenting upon the merits of the controversy or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide representation Annexure P-2 and legal notice Annexure P-3 in accordance with law within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case the petitioner is found entitled to the relief claimed, the benefits be released to the petitioner within a period of two weeks from the date of decision of the representation/legal notice.
