The petitioners have filed the present criminal writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India with the following prayers:-

“i. Issue of writ order or direction especially in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents no. 2 and 3 for taking action against respondents nos. 4 to 9 and for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners.

ii. Any other writ, order or direction may also be issued to respondent no.2 to decide the representation dated 5.6.2020 (Annexure P-8) moved by the petitioners.”

From the facts narrated in the petition, it is clear that civil litigation is pending in this Court. A civil writ petition was decided against the petitioners. They filed Letters Patent Appeal which is stated to

be pending and interim order for maintenance of status quo has been passed. The petitioners allege that the private respondents have cut away and removed the Sheesham trees and also put on fire residue of the wheat crop.

It may be noted here that petitioners filed COCP-2984-2019 for initiation of proceedings under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 which was later on withdrawn.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court is of the considered view that the petitioners have failed to make out a case for issuance of directions as prayed for. The petitioners are, therefore, relegated to the remedy of filing complaint before the Judicial Magistrate.
