The petitioner-Nirmal Singh has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for quashing of order dated 8.6.2009 declaring him a proclaimed offender. Occurrence in question is alleged to have taken place in the year 1999 whereas FIR was registered on 20.2.2007. The petitioner applied for pre-arrest bail which was dismissed on 9.8.2019. Thereafter, once again the petitioner did not take any step.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court is not inclined to interfere in exercise of its power under Section 482 Cr.P.C. The petitioner, if so advised, may surrender before the Trial Court and apply for bail. If after surrender the petitioner files an application for grant of bail, the same shall be decided within one week.
