The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Ashok, stated to be aged 66 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer to direct the respondents to release pension of Rs.10,000/- to the petitioner being the survival of the emergency victim.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Sukhdeep Parmar, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with same/similar submissions, a legal notice dated 15.01.2020, was served upon the respondents.

Without commenting upon merits of the case, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the legal notice within a period of three months from the

date of receipt of copy of the order. Considering the present situation due to COVID-19, learned State counsel and Registry is directed to send the order through e-mail to the concerned authorities for necessary compliance.

Writ petition is disposed of accordingly.
