The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.67 dated 18.05.2020, registered under Sections 458, 323, 324, 34, 120-B IPC at Police Station Moonak, District Sangrur.

The operative part of the order dated 17.06.2020, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“....Notice of motion.

Mr. Ajay Pal S. Gill, Dy. Advocate General, Punjab to accept notice on behalf of the Respondent/State. A copy of the paperbook be supplied to him.

Adjourned to 16.09.2020....”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 17.06.2020, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation. Counsel for the petitioner has also placed on record the photocopy of the compromise
