Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.178 dated 10.03.2020 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 307, 427, 506, 120-B of IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Yamuna Nagar City, District Yamuna Nagar, Haryana.

In compliance of the order dated 18.06.2020, counsel for the petitioner has placed on record a copy of the application filed by him under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. along with the affidavit of Manoj Kumar-complainant. Same is taken on record.

Vide order dated 18.06.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jai Bhagwan, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case and the order dated 18.06.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
