These matter are being taken up for hearing through video
conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Prayer in these petitions is for grant of anticipatory bail to the

petitioner (s) in FIR No. 110 dated 11.10.2019, under Sections 323, 324, 452, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Ajitwal, District Moga.

It is submitted that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the abovementioned FIR due to certain misunderstandings. Section 326 IPC, was added at a later stage. Moreover, the matter, it is submitted has been amicably resolved between the parties. All the petitioners have joined investigation and they undertake to fully cooperate with the investigating agency and not abuse the concession of anticipatory bail, if afforded to them. It is thus prayed that all these petitions be allowed.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Dharampal Singh, verifies that the petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

Learned counsel for the complainant affirms and verifies that the complainant has no objection, in case, these petitions are allowed.

There are no allegations on behalf of the State that the petitioners are likely to abscond or they are likely to dissuade the witnesses from deposing true facts before the learned trial Court, if granted the concession of anticipatory bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above but without commenting upon or expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, these petitions are allowed.

In the event of arrest of the petitioners, they be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/investigating Officer. The petitioners shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so. Petitioners shall

comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is clarified that none of the observations made hereinabove shall be construed to be a reflection on the merits of the case. The same are solely confined for the purpose of decision of the present petition.
