The petitioner is a single girl aged about 32 years. She alleges that on account of being a girl child she is being harassed by her family members. The parents want to give all their property to their only son and for this purpose they are bent upon either eliminating the petitioner or involving her in false criminal cases. Thus, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 07.06.2020 (Annexure P-1) before respondents No. 2 and 3 but they have failed to take any action to protect her life and liberty.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

Ms. Monika Jalota, DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 and waives service.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the contents of the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the petition with direction to respondent No. 2 to positively consider the representation dated 07.06.2020 (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate action in accordance with law thereupon within a period of 14 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. It shall be ensured that no harm is caused to the petitioner.
