Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.87 dated 26.05.2020 under Sections 376, 420, 120-B, 506 and 342 IPC, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib, Punjab. He apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 18.06.2020 whereby while issuing notice of motion to the respondent-State, the interim protection was extended to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that in deference to the said order, the petitioner submitted himself before the Police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioner cooperated with the Police Authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by SI Amarpreet Brar does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and states that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 18.06.2020 is made absolute.
